



## Bus Rules and Agreement

1. The driver of a school bus is in complete charge of the passengers while they are aboard the bus and should be given the same respect as a classroom teacher.
2. Students should conduct themselves in an acceptable manner at all times.
3. The aisle of the bus must remain free of books, bags and any other objects.
4. No food or drink on the bus.
5. Passengers are to keep their arms, head, or other parts of the body inside the bus at all times.
6. Passengers will not tamper with the emergency door, fire extinguisher, or other safety equipment on the bus.
7. Students will assist the driver in keeping the bus clean by discarding trash in an appropriate trash receptacle.
8. Students found responsible for damage, defacement, or vandalism will be charged for the damages in conjunction with other disciplinary action.
9. Eating, drinking, chewing gum and using tobacco products are strictly prohibited on school buses.
10. Students will remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop. Upon arrival at school, students in the front seats will leave the bus first and all will exit in an orderly fashion.
11. Students are allowed to leave the bus only at previously designated stops.
12. Any complaints against any driver/monitor should be directed to the Superintendent.
